

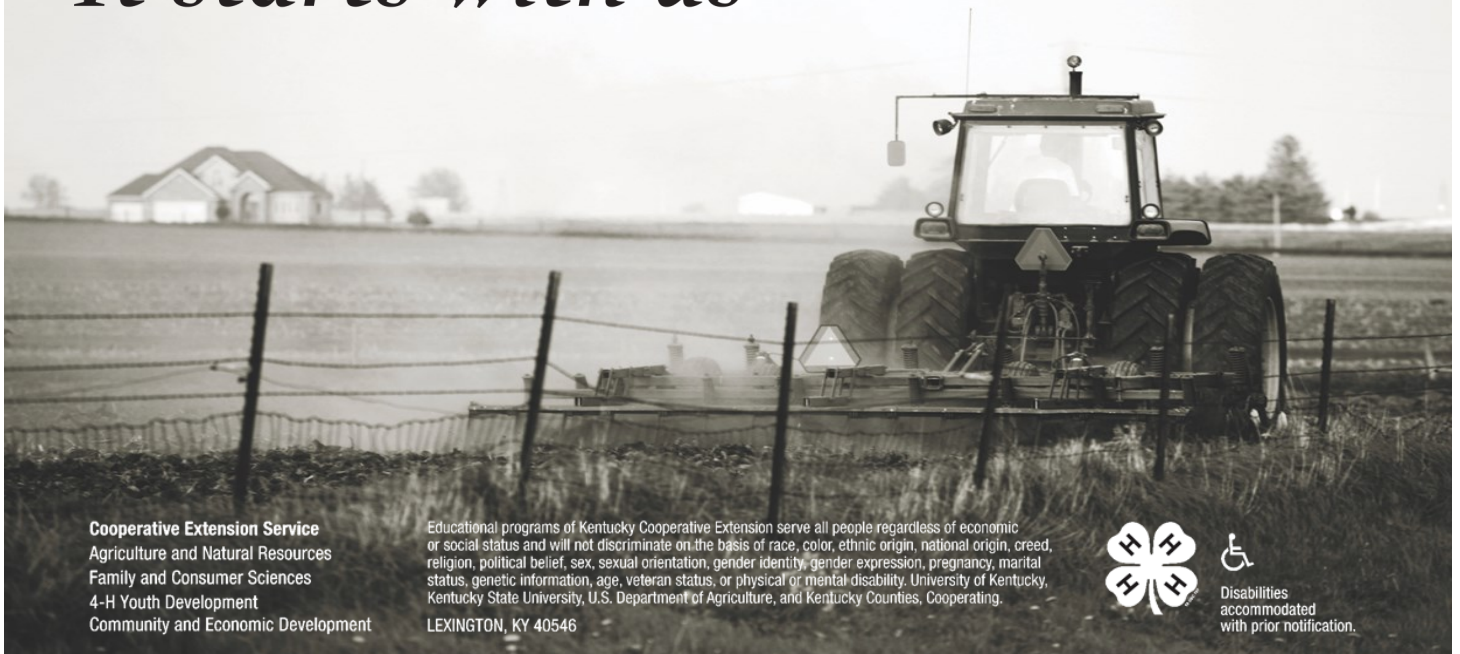
# What is the Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service?

The Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service provides practical education you can trust to help people, businesses, and communities solve problems, develop skills, and build a better future. Extension agriculture and horticulture programs are part of the outreach of the Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service. We provide informal education in agricultural production, environmental stewardship and horticulture practices.

- Livestock producers who were impacted by the Extension Service: 33,329
- Forest acreage positively impacted by Extension programming: 32,453
- Producers who implemented sustainable practices: 5,388
- Residents reporting an increase in accessing fresh, local foods: 11,066
- Grain crop producers who adopted practices that improved environment and water quality: 2,295
- Individuals who reported an increase in fruit and/or vegetable consumption: 42,304
