

# NACAA Chile Agriculture and Cultural Study Tour November 8-15, 2025

\*November 7th - Evening overnight flight to Santigo, Chile (airport code SCL).

**Day 1 - (Saturday, November 8)** All flights from the US will arrive in Santiago early morning. You will transfer through immigration and connect to your flight to Puerto Montt (you will book this along with your international flight so your checked bags will go directly to Puerto Montt).

Home airport > SCL > (give yourself 2.5 hour layover) > PMC (Latam airlines flight 311 @ 12:22pm)

Upon an early afternoon arrival, transfer to your Puerto Varas hotel with amazing views of the Osorno volcano. Orientation, explore the town and later in the day have a welcome dinner!

**Day 2 - (Sunday, November 9)** Full day trip to Chiloe Island (Northern Patagonia), the birthplace of the most cultivated potato varieties in the world. Visit a cathedral, stilt houses, and picturesque towns! Also enjoy a *curanto* lunch which is a traditional method of cooking food using heated rocks buried in an earth oven that is covered with *pangue* leaves and turf. Also a possibility to see penguins (not guaranteed). (Overnight Puerto Varas)

Day 3 - (Monday, November 10) Next, check out of your hotel and head off into the countryside visiting some livestock producers. You will visit a dairy farm followed by lunch and a visit to a sheep farm which are both one of the major industries for Chilean agriculture.

**Day 4 - (Tuesday, November 11)** Begin with a presentation by a member from SOFO, the regional farmers association who will focus the discussion on animal agriculture production in Chile. Next, visit a small farm which breeds llamas and alpacas, South American native animals. You will also enjoy lunch at the farm and possibly meet with a veterinarian. Next, visit a local cattle farm. First, enjoy a tour of one of the wineries with a focus on animal enhancement integrated into the farm. Next, travel to Vina del Mar for lunch on the Pacific Ocean and visit the best botanical garden in Chile. Following lunch, visit Valparaiso, famous for its colorful homes and was once a major port city before the Panama Canal was built. Possible visit to the Vina del Mar botanical garden (pending opening). Travel back to Santiago to freshen up at the hotel before a farewell dinner and a cultural Chilean folk music and dancing program!

Founded in 1541, it is also the financial, political and cultural center of Chile. On your tour, you will see such places as the Plaza de Armas (the historical city center), the Palacio de La Moneda (the Presidential Palace), and Quinta Normal (the city's museum district). In the afternoon, have some free time to explore before traveling to the airport and your return flight to the US.
